Finds him for Juliet other times too. • Said after Romeo killed Tybalt that there isn't trust, faith or honesty in men. All of them lie. All of them cheat. They're all wicked. Shame on Romeo! “ No faith, no honesty in men. All perjured, All forsworn, all naught, all dissemblers. Ah, where's my man?—Give me some aqua vitae.— These griefs, these woes, these sorrows make me old. Shame come to Romeo!” (PAGE 160) • (Says they should take a vacation in Mantua.) • Advises (Tells) Juliet to marry Paris and forget about Romeo - Hurts Juliet more than the nurse would have thought. Juliet says she will never marry Paris. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Both help get them together. (Friar marries them and Nurse put up the ladder for Romeo to climb over the wall.) • Both support their relationship. • Only people that know about their marriage. • Contributed to their death/ the cause of their death. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • (Disagrees with Romeo at first about marrying them.) • Surprised Romeo has given up on Rosaline. • Says men are unreliable. • Scolded Romeo for obsessing about Rosaline. • Agrees to marry them secretly. (Disapproves, but marries them anyway) - HOPES IT WILL END THE FAMILIES' FEUD • Tells Romeo that they should love each other in moderation. • Can tell the future - that they will both die.
